

Monday (Mar.17 th)	<p>Scripture: Mark 13:14-31</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> How did Jesus describe the “<i>abomination that causes desolation</i>”? Vs. 14-19 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What <i>tensions do you feel/get</i> from Christ’s description of the end of time? What <i>attribute(s) of God</i> can you find in verse 20 and how does it <i>encourage your faith in Him</i>? As Christian, what do you do on a <i>regular basis to be on your guard</i> for false prophets & their teachings? Vs. 21-23 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What will happen to our <i>fallen world in Christ’s second coming</i>? Vs. 24-30 What does <i>verse 31 tell you about God’s words and your faith in him/them</i>?
Tuesday (Mar.18 th)	<p>Scripture: Mark 13:32-37</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> What <i>map</i> did Jesus give us about the <i>future Day and the Hour</i>? Vs. 32-34 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What <i>task has Jesus assigned and put you in charge</i> until his return and how are you <i>handling it</i> (faithfully and obediently)? How did <i>Jesus teach us to keep watch and prepare for his return</i>? Vs. 35-37 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Examine your daily activities. Where do you <i>spend most of your time and energy</i>? <i>If Jesus suddenly comes</i>, what do you think <i>he would find you doing</i>? At this moment in <i>your spiritual condition</i>, do you think <i>Jesus is pleased with you</i>? Why/why not? What are your <i>strategic plans to spiritual improvement</i>?
Wednesday (Mar.19 th)	<p>Scripture: Mark 14:1-11</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> How did Mark <i>contrast</i> the chief priests, teachers of the law, those who rebuked the woman, and Judas Iscariot’s action versus that of the woman? Vs.1-5, 10-11 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How did Mark <i>describe the woman’s gift & her presentation to Jesus</i>? Vs. 3 Which <i>role would you see yourself in</i>: the woman, those who rebuked the woman’s action or others (who)? Why? How did <i>Jesus rebuke those who rebuked the woman</i>? Vs. 6-9 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What is the <i>most valuable thing in your life you could broke to offer up to Jesus</i>? Why? How would you describe a <i>devoted Christian/follower of Christ</i>¹? Are you <i>deeply devoted in your faith</i>? Why/why not?
Thursday (Mar.20 th)	<p>Scripture: Mark 14:12-26</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> From Jesus’ instructions to the disciples about the preparation of the Passover meal, what can you say about <i>Jesus’ personalities/characters</i>? Vs. 12-16 If you were one of the Twelve, how would you <i>react towards what Jesus said in verses 18-21</i>? <i>Imagine you are Judas Iscariot, how would you behave/react</i>? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What is the <i>order of the Lord’s Supper</i>? <i>Why is it important</i>? Vs. 22-25 How is <i>Christ’s body and blood related to the covenant</i>? That is, what is <i>God’s commitment to his people in the new covenant</i>? <i>Examine/evaluate your attitude at the church monthly Lord’s Supper</i>. Do you <i>seriously/fearfully reflect on what Christ did for you</i> and joyfully celebrate his victory? How so?

Friday (Mar.21 st)	<p>Scripture: Mark 14:27-31</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> What do you think <i>Jesus was thinking and feeling</i> as he predicts the disciples’ denial, esp. Peters, and they insisted emphatically they would not? Vs. 27-30 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Would you say <i>Peter was too certain of his faithfulness toward Jesus</i>? Why/why not? Vs. 29-31 <i>If you were Peter</i>, how would you <i>feel about Jesus’ prediction of your denial</i> when you honestly think you would not deny him? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What <i>factors</i> do you think <i>cause a Christian to disown/deny Jesus</i>? Though knowing these factors, we are still weak sinners; how would you <i>help yourself to stay faithful in Christ</i>?
Saturday (Mar.22 nd)	<p>Scripture: Mark 14:32-42</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> How did Mark <i>describe Jesus’ emotions</i> in that very moment? Vs. 32-34 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If <i>Jesus was not dreaded for death itself</i>, why do you think <i>he was overwhelmed with sorrow</i> and asked <i>if God is willing, take the cup from him</i>? How did <i>Jesus address God</i> in his prayers and what does it tell you <i>about their relationship</i>? Vs. 35-36 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Examine how <i>you address God</i> in your prayers and <i>reflect on your relationship with him</i>. What is that <i>one thing Jesus wanted his disciples to do and why</i>? How did the disciples respond? Vs. 37-41 What is the <i>one thing in your life that you really want to overcome</i>, yet “<i>the spirit is willing, but the body is weak</i>”? What are you going to do?
Sunday (Mar.23 rd)	<p>Scripture: Psalms 43</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> How did the Psalmist pray to God for <i>deliverance from the enemy and restoration to God’s presence</i>? Vs. 1-4 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Why do you think we can sadly <i>consider Canada as an ungodly nation</i>? What <i>role can you take</i> to help our country to come back to God? How did the <i>Psalmist describe God</i> and why do you think such descriptions are important to him at that moment? Vs. 2-5 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At <i>this moment in your life or spiritual situation</i>, who is <i>God to you</i>? Why? How do you <i>usually express your praises to God</i>? When was the <i>last time you expressed such praises</i> (under what circumstances)?
