How is it that people participate in some miracles through obedience, when in others they do not? 3. When did you discover what it meant to be on God’s side and take direction from him, rather than having him serve you on your side? 4. What walled-in area of your life are you still protecting or hiding behind? How could God give you victory over those walls if you follow his ways?
Tuesday (Oct 7 th)	<p><u>Scripture: Joshua 7:1-15</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How would you describe Joshua’s reaction to the defeat at Ai: Cowardly? Angry? Whining? Surprised? Had you been there what elements of each do you see in yourself? 2. How did the Lord get Joshua and the Israelites back on track?
Wednesday (Oct 8 th)	<p><u>Scripture: Joshua 7:16-26</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What exactly was Achan’s sin? Why do you think he did it even though he knew God’s orders? 2. If you had been Joshua, would you have been tempted to let Achan go with a slap on the wrist? Send him packing? Physically hitting him? What does this say about your style of disciplining those you feel responsible at home or work?
Thursday (Oct 9 th)	<p><u>Scripture: Joshua 8:1-17</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What does the Lord say to Joshua now to encourage him in a second attack to Ai? How is this attack to differ from the first one? 2. What does Joshua do to encourage any less than enthusiastic soldiers before the battle? 3. Is there some area in your life right now in which you hear the Lord saying to you, “Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged”?
Friday (Oct 10 th)	<p><u>Scripture: Joshua 8:18-35</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What do you think was the attitude of the Ai’s king and soldiers when the battle began? How did this attitude lead them to defeat? 2. Have you ever had an occasion when your own self-

Saturday (Oct 11 th)	<p><u>Scripture: Joshua 9:1-15</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Why do you suppose the ruse by the Gibeonites worked? In this regard, what is the significance of sampling but not inquiring? 2. Have you ever made a promise which later turned out to be difficult or unpopular to keep?
Sunday (Oct 12 th)	<p><u>Scripture: Psalm 70</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What does the psalmist expect God to be to him, and to do for him, and what will such things make him do? Do you make similar confessions to God when you pray?
